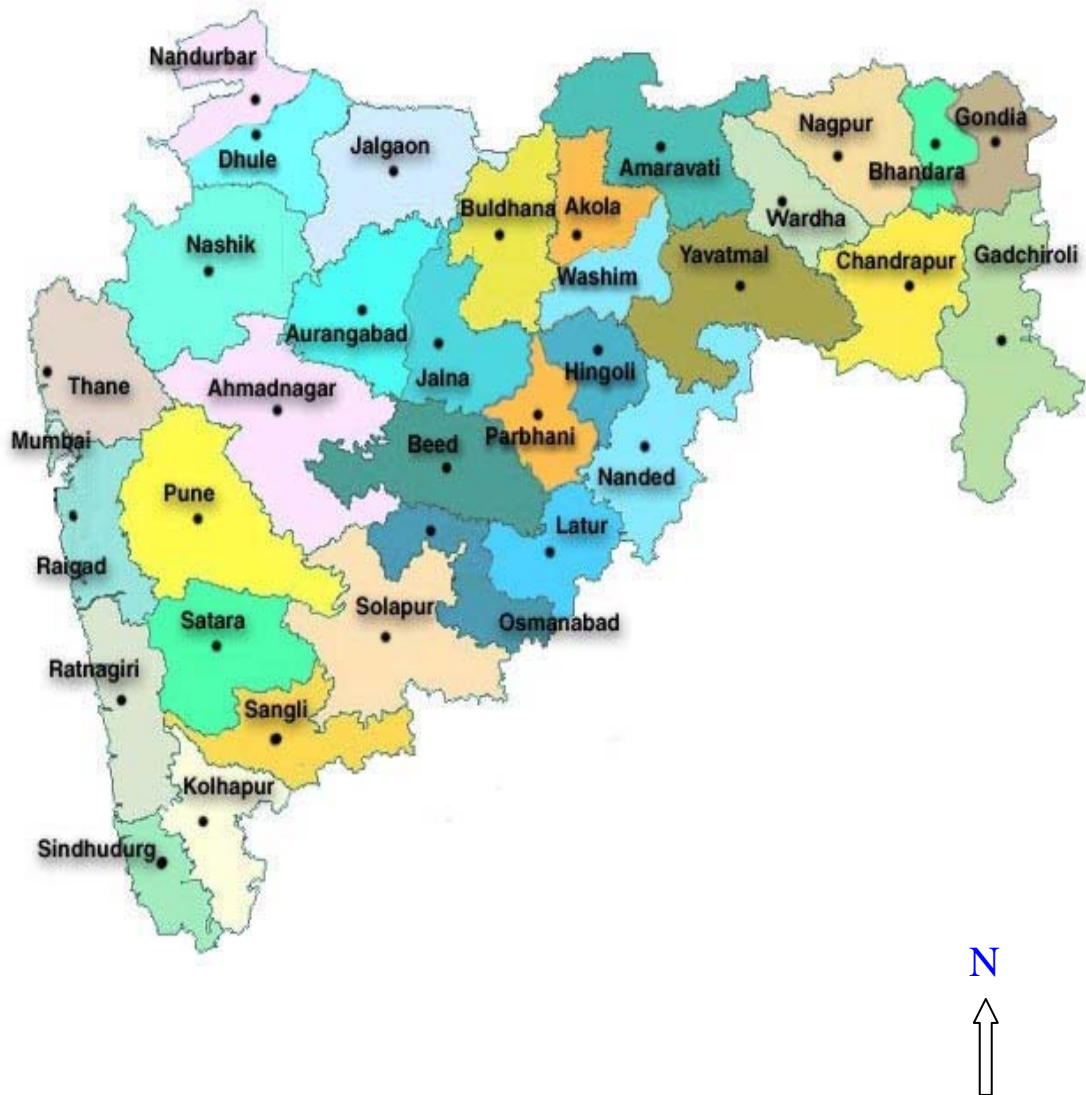

INTRODUCTION OF DISTRICT

A) Location :-

The location of Kolhapur district is shown in the map of Maharashtra. It is situated in the extreme southern part of the Maharashtra state. It lies between $15^{\circ}.43$ and $17^{\circ}.17$ north latitude and $73^{\circ}.40$ and $73^{\circ}.42$ east longitude.

B) Boundaries :-

Kolhapur is bounded by Ratnagiri and Sindhudurg districts to the west, by Sangli to the north and by Karnataka State to the east and south. The Shyadri ranges to the west and Warana River to the north form the natural boundaries.

C) Area :-

The district has an area of 76.85 sq. km. which is about 2.50 % of the total area of the state. It ranks 24th in the terms of area of the state.

D) Educational Background :-

In Kolhapur district, the eastern sector of Chandgad block, the eastern sector to Gadhinglaj block the eastern and southern sector to Kagal block and the southern sector of Shirol block is near the boundary to Karnataka State. So, there is influence to Kannadde language in this boundary area. That's why the students in this area can't achieve linguistic skills properly / easily so they have lack of knowledge in language

Climate & Rainfall:

A) Rainfall -

The district gets rains from the south-west as well as the north east monsoons. The amount of rainfall received decreases rapidly from west to east. The range between maximum and minimum is large and vagaries of rainfall are great. The average annual rainfall within the district varies widely from about 600 mm. in Shirol taluka in the east to 6000 mm. in Bavda taluka in west. Due to variations in rainfall from year to year and from place to place, it difficult to divide the district rainfall zones

B) Temperature :-

The climate of Kolhapur is generally temperate. The western part of Kolhapur district is hilly and at a height. Climate in this area is, therefore cool. The climate becomes hot and dry as one goes toward the east. The eastern taluka's of Karvir, Hatkanagle, Gadhinglaj and Kagal have hot climate. In winter, day temperatures remain higher than the monsoon Season, the mean minimum temperature is the lowest and it ranges from 14°C . To 16°C . December and January

are the coldest months of the year. There is rapid rise in temperature in the month of March, reaching maximum in the month of April.

C) **Seasons -**

The year (season) in respect of Kolhapur district may be divided into three periods, hot weather from March to May, rainy period from June to October, and cold weather from November to February.

D) **Educational Background : -**

Chandgad, Ajara, GagadaBawada & Radhanagari blocks in Kolhapur district have mountainous & hilly area so the overlarge of rainfall is highest within these blocks. Therefore in month June to September the attendance ratio of students is lower in this heavy rainfall zone. There is fairly regular rainfall in the blocks panhala, Shahuwad and Bhudargad. The Kagal. Hatkanagale, Karveer & Gadhinglaj blocks receiving low, irregular & uncertain rainfall. The students in these schools can't affect on attendance by rainfall.

1.1 **Means of livelihood:**

In Kolhapur district livelihood stage is middle class, many person are farm workers. A lot of peoples depends on dairy farms and agriculture. So many Sugar factories and Industrial area in Kolhapur district, so that living of people is in good condition.

1.2 **Industries:**

Maharashtra is one of the advanced states in the country as far as industries are concerned. Similarly Kolhapur is also one of the industrially advanced districts of the state. Presence of railway link, better road links, better infrastructure for industrialization etc. play a better role in the development of industry. Kolhapur has been fortunate to have there infrastructures. There are many large, medium and small scale industries in the district - mainly Kolhapur, Ichalkarnji an industrial belt.

A) **Large scale Industries. :-**

Sugar factories, factories producing milk products, oil mill, textile mills and machinery making are the large scale industries in the district.

B) **Sugar factories :-**

There are many sugar factories in Karvir, Shirol, Hatkanagale, Panhala, Gadhinglaj, Chandgad, Kagal etc. Paper is produced as a by product from bagasse in Warananagar. Jaggery is produced on a large in a district. The varies sugar factories in the district have created a unique place in the country.

C) **OIL MILLS. :-**

Oil mills are located at Karvir, Hatkanagale, Shirol, and Gadhinglaj talukas.

D) **TEXTILE MILLS :-**

There is a textile mills at Kolhapur, Ichalkarnji and are some power looms at Kolhapur. There are spinning mills at Ichalkaranji, Shradwad, Yadrav, Ragoli etc. Ichalkaranji is called "**Machester of Maharashtra**".

E) **MILK PRODUCESS :-**

The large milk projects Gokul, Morana, Warana, Mayur, are known in all over India. Various milk products are prepared there.

F) **OTHER FACTORIES :-**

There are factories manufacturing aluminum, utensils at Kolhapur, Uchgaon and Jaisingpur. The machinery industry at kolhapur is famous.

G) **SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES :-**

The small scale industries include leather industries, cotton yarn production, cement pipes, oil engines, iron implements, printing machines etc. Dairy industry and hatcheries are also among the other industries. Shoes are made in and around kolhapur. Hupari in Hatkangale taluka is famous for its silver ornaments. Ichalkaranji is famous for handlooms and power looms. Other industries in the district are making bidis and weaving rough blankets & rice mills.

MIDC has developed about 546.14 hectares of land in Shirol and Gokul Shiragaon Villages for setting up of industries. These plots are given to small scale as well as large scale industries.

Thus kolhapur is progressing industrially. The standard of living of the people has improved because of the constant progress and development of industries.

H) **Educational Background :-**

Kolhapur is one of the industrially advanced district in Maharashtra. There are many sugar factories in Kagal, Karveer, Shirol, Hatkanangale, Panhala, Chandgad, Ganganbawada, Bhudargad, Ajara, Shahuwadi. There are sugar schools projected for workers children. Sugar factories and industrial area developed in Shirol, Hatkanangle, Karveer & Kolhapur city. Sugar schools and Mahatma Phule Education guarantee scheme. (MPEGS) are started for there children. Stone schools are stared in Karveer and Hatkanangle.

1.5 Transport & Communication:

The modes of transport in the kolhapur district are roads and railways.

A) **ROADS:-**

NATIONAL HIGHWAY :-

The Pune – Bangalore national highway passes through kolhapur district. The road further leads ot Bangalore in the karnataka state. Kini, Shirol, Kolhapur and Kagal are the places in Kolhapur district are on the national way. The length of the National highway is 47 Km.

B) **MAIN ROADS**

KOLHAPUR – RATNAGIRI ROAD :-

This road passes through Karvir, Panhala and Shahuwadi Talukas and leads towards Amba Ghat

KOLHAPUR –PHONDA ROAD :-

Ghotawade, Radhanagari and Dajipur are the places on this road. The important places in Sindhudurg district are connected by this road.

KOLHAPUR – SANGALI ROAD :-

This road leads to Sangali, Rukadi, Hatkangale, Jaisingpur are located on this road. There are many other roads and sub-roads in the district. Most of the villages are connected either by a pucca road or a kachcha approach road to one or the other main road. The length of the district and rural ways are 1664 Kms and 3554 Kms respectively. The district enjoys a good system of communication facility by bus routes. Six villages are reported to be accessible by footy path only.

C) **RAILWAYS**

KOLHAPUR – MIRAJ RAILWAY :-

The district headquarter kolhapur has been joined to Mumbai (Capital of Maharashtra) by broad gauge railway line of South Central division of Indian railwayline. Rukadi, Hatkangale, Jaisingpur etc. are the six railway stations with 37.68 Km. Of railway line. Daily train services are available from Bombay and many other important places to kolhapur.

D) **Educational Background :**

The modes of transport in Kolhapur district are roads and railways. The transport facility is completely available in eastern region of Kolhapur district. The Pune-Banglore national highway and Belgum-Sawantwadi state highway passes through kolhapur district. All educational facilities are available in villages which situated on there highways. Plain roads or other transport facilities are not available in vast and hilly area of western regain of kolhapur district. The students walks 2 km to 4 km to reach shepherd houses & dwellings in Chandgad, Radhanagari, Ajara & Bhudargad blocks. That's why all education facilities can't available to children who lives in this hills and vast area.

1.6 The way of life:

The life of the people in village is different from the life of the people in city. This differences can be seen in their dress, types of houses, food habits. and occupations, their days and festivals. All these thing taken together are known as their way of life.

1) THE WAY OF LIFE IN VILLAGES :-

Kolhapur is the district of villages. Out of total district population 73.67 percent live in villages. Their way of life is simple.

A) FOOD :- Generally, they eat the kind of food grains that they produce in the region. Rice is the main article of food. They eat 'Bhakari' made of Jowar or wheat chapatis, Dal, Vegetables chutney, onions etc. are also included in the diet. On festive occasions a special sweet dish like 'Puranpoli' is prepared. On some occasions, they prepared 'Kolhapuri Mutton Curry', their favorite dish.

B) CLOTHES :- The farmers generally wears a dhoti and a shirt. He wears a cap or a turban. Some of them wear a shirt and a pair of pyjamas. Ladies wear a nine yard sari and a choli. Nowadays women in the villages have started wearing a six yard sari and a blouse.

C) HOUSES :- The houses have sloping roofs. The walls of houses are built in brick and mud. Some people live in huts. The walls of huts are built in mud or plastered with mud. The houses some people live in are big in size. Such houses are built in stone, brick, mortar or cement.

D) OCCUPATIONS :- The main occupation among country folk is agriculture. They also keep milch animals, goats, sheep and poultry. Some of people make earthen pots and pans, articles of wood leather and iron.

E) FAIRS AND ENTERTAINMENTS :- Many people attend fairs or jataras (melas) Some of the entertainers sing powada or lavani songs to entertain people. People also like to listen to Kirtanas and Bhajans. Kabaddi, Khokho, Volleyball cricket are games which children in countryside love to play. Now a days the radio as well as TV have come to be a means of entertainment in most villages.

F) HOLIDAYS AND FESTIVALS :- During the course of the years people celebrate days and festivals like Gudhi Padava, Dasara, Diwali, Holi, Ram-navmi, Id, Mahavir Jayanti, Christmas etc. So also Independence day and Republic-day are celebrated as National festivals.

2) THE WAY OF LIFE IN CITIES :-

The life of the people in the cities are quite different from the life of the people in village.

A) FOOD :- The daily food of the town folk mainly includes wheat chapatis, rice jowar bhakari, curry and various vegetables. Some people eat meat, fish and eggs. Special sweet dishes are cooked on holyday.

B) CLOTHES :- Men-folk in towns wear shirts and pants. Women wear saris of different colours. Young boys and girls wear clothes made in different styles and fashions.

C) HOUSES :- The houses in cities are of different-kinds. A large number of them are built in concrete. Facilities like water, electricity, water closets are provided in most of the houses.

D) OTHER FACILITIES :- There are various facilities for education in cities. Facilities like libraries, post offices, banks, hospitals etc are available.

E) ENTERTAINMENTS :- There are places of entertainment like cinema halls and theaters. They enjoy television inter-net facilities. The people in cities too celebrate holy days and festivals and also national festivals.

The people of Kolhapur are medium in height and color of the skin is brown and they are living friendly with each other.

1.7 Economic status of the people:

There are many means of livelihood in Kolhapur dist. Most of people are farmers. In hilly area like chandgad, Ajara, Bhudargad, Radhanagari, Shahuwadi, and Gaganbawada mostly people are poor. They live on daily wages. So that their children also work to improve their economical condition. But though their economical condition is not good, they work hard for education. In Industrial area like Kolhapur, Kagal, Shirol most of the people are economically surrounded

1.8 Historical Background:

Kolhapur has a long history that dates back to the great Maratha emperor Chh. Shivaji Maharaj Maharani Tarabai and Chh. Shahu Maharaj. The poet Moropant, Lahari Haidar, Master Vinaik, V. Shantaram etc. all great figures belong to kolhapur district. Kolhapur is known as the Kashi of South. Tanicent temple of Mahalaxmi was initially built by the Chalukya kings in the sixth century. The body of the temple is built of local black trap without of any timber. It has no opening for air except a few doors. The kopeswar temple situated at Khidrapur is a fine example of ancient sculpture also. Panhala, Vishalgad etc. ancient forts. The walls, gateways and towers are almost entirely ruined. The Town Hall, old palace etc. are some of the historical places in kolhapur.

Chh. Shahu Maharaj gave a lot of education facilities to all at that time he had forced to take education to all children . There was a fine to the parents for irregular attendance of their students. They established hostels for students belongs to back words class and poor families . He opened many education institutes, because of this historical background the education tradition of Kolhapur district is outstanding.

Kolhapur has also a lions share in the freedom struggle of India. Thousands of youth actually took part in the freedom struggle answering the call of Mahatama Gandhi, Hundreds of which were put into the jail. And several of them gave up their lives. Thus the contribution of kolhapur is a glorious page in the movement of freedom struggle.

A) Educational Background :

Kolhapur has a long history that dates back to the great Maratha emperor Chh. Shivaji Maharaj, Maharani Tarabai and Chh. Shahu Maharaj. The educational tradition of Kolhapur district is outstanding. A lot of social reformers and Kings motivated to society for educating their children in British reign these are shepherd hours and dwellings. Because of vast, forest region and heavy rainfall people in this area are economically backward so their children can't get proper education.

Education generalization begins after opening of Dwelling school since 2001. The number of Dwelling schools is 59 in Radhanagari 11 in chandgad, 19 in Gaganbawada. 25 in Bhudargad, 7 in Ajara, 19 in Panhala and 40 in Shahuwadi. There are 250 Dwelling schools start and 12 schools projected in Kolhapur district. Chh. Shahu Maharaj gave a lot of educational facilitation to all. In that time they had forced to take education to all children. These was a fine to parents for irregular attendance of their students. They established hostels for students belongs to backward class and poor families. They opened many education institutes because of this historical background the education tradition of Kolhapur district is outstanding.

1.9 Social Activities:

The social development of the district is really astonishing. The great visionary king of Kolhapur Sansthan Chh. Shahu Maharaj is rightly called as a royal revolutionary of the society. He was the greatest social reformer. He was the ruler who made a law and free compulsory primary education in this state. He conducted to Bedam Powall in 1917 and established the scout movement in the district. He established the hostels for various students together and played important role in social work. Truly the all rounded development of Kolhapur is the result of Chh. Shahu mission & his foresight.

The 'Lions Club' is one of the important social institution in the district working for the benefit of the society. For the orphans 'The Anathashrams' do work as a humanity. Narim a Hurzuk a social reformer, is being worked remarkably for handicapped.

As many other districts, our district is full of superstitions, Maharashtra Andhshradha Nirmulan, play important role in this field. Devadasi Movement is doing great job, giving new life to the poor helpless women.

A) Educational Background :

The social development of the district is really astonishing different caste and religion people live together prosperously.

There are multi language schools started for their children. Marathi, English, Urdu, and Gujrati medium schools are starting here separately. Urdu mediums Madarsa Maktab are starting in Hatkanangle block

1.10 Cultural Activities:

Kolhapur district is one of the frontline districts of India in the field of Art, Education, Culture, Music, Sports, Cinema etc. A brief account of main activities is given below –

A) WRESTLING – Kolhapur is known for wrestling. A big wrestling stadium was built by Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj. It produced world class wrestler like Shripati Khanchanale, Ganpati Andhalkar, Maruthi Mane who got Hindkesari Award, Khashappa Jadhav won the branz in olympic and Andhalkar was honoured by Arjun Award.

B) LITERATURE – Kolhapur has given many literatures. It is known for newness and differences in style. The main poets who made marathi poetry more colourful were Shri Moropant, Lahri Haider, Shahir Sarnaik famous poets Suryakant Khandekar, Jagadish Khebudkar etc. and well known author V.S khandekar, Madhav Julian, N.C. Phadke etc. made Kolhapur district very proud. Writers like Mrutynjaykar - Shivaji Sawant, Baba Kadam, Ramesh Mantri, Ranjeet Desai added weight to Kolhapur district.

C) INDIAN CINEMA – It has been the birth place of Marathi film industry. It has produced many writers, producers, directors, talented actors etc. World famous director V. Shantaram, Baburao Painter, Master Vinayak belong to the district. Bhalaji Pendharkar and Indians melody queen Lata Mangeshkar belong to the district.

D) FAIRS – Most of the fairs held in the district are associated with important deities and religious festivals. "Jotiba fair" is the greatest fair in the Maharashtra, held in the month of March /April for 8 days. It is said that the small temple of Jyotiba now in existence is over 2000 years old. During fairdays people of different caste visit in Jotiba more than 5 Lakhs.

"Navaratra Utsav" at Dasara is the great religious festival celebrated in Kolhapur. The small but picturesque Trymboli Temple sacred in legends. A big fair is held here on the 5th day of Aswin.

E) Educational Background : Kolhapur district is one of the front line district of India in the field of Art Education, Cultural music, sports and cinema. The cultural tradition of kolhapur is very effective for education development. Different festivals, competitions, cultural programme woman conference and child happiness meetings are arranged in schools. There school related programme are useful for child all round development. All schools become clean, tidy and beautiful with the help of villages in 'Sant Gadge Baba Gram Swachhta Abhiyan'. The village jainyaal in Kagal block is eligible for state level competition. The education development in such villages is outstanding.

The people in Chandgad block celebrate 'Holi & Dhahikala' yearly about 15 days, so the attendance of students in school is very low. These festivals celebrate for more time. There are a lot of efforts doing for increasing students school attendance with the help of Gramsabha, Parents Meeting & Gram Shikshan samitee.

Introduction of Agency

As per guidelines of MPSP, Mumbai, A Social Work College or the NGO who has experience of Educational Survey to be selected for the Sample checking. The CEO Z.P. Kolhapur selected NGO named Krushi Vikas Vidnyan Mandal Bubnal Tal. Shirol Dist. Kolhapur The Sample checking was done with the help of the trained Volunteers of our Educational Society.

The Volunteers of our Educational Society have experience of many types of Survey , Training and other activities in Government projects such as Educational Survey at SSA Sangali ,seasonal Schools for out of school etc. For this 5 % Sample checking of School Information our Volunteers were actually go to the school level and collect all relevant data as per format provided by Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan, Z.P. Kolhapur. They did this with great efforts, team work and with well plan.

Process of 5 % EMIS Sample Checking

❖ Process of EMIS 5% Checking

As per the guidelines given by the MPSP, the name of the Krushi Vikas Vidnyan Mandal Bubnal Tal. Shirol Dist. Kolhapur has finalized for the survey of EMIS 5 % Sample Checking. The training of Surveyors are arranged at district level for filling up the Sample checking Format and EMIS Format. Information regarding variables used in DCF formats is given to the surveyors. The survey format given to them was very comprehensive and covered almost all the aspect regarding a primary education. The queries and important suggestion were given to them.

The office has given an identification and permission letter to the Surveyors with the signature of Education Officer (P), so that this letter could be shown to the Headmasters of the schools to be surveyed.

A block wise list was prepared by the programmer of all schools including all the managements and given to the surveyors. Most of the important information was given with the list like school management, cluster, school type, school category, area of school. The random sampling was made for the survey according to the guidelines given to us by MPSP

- All 12 blocks and 1 corporation area within the district were covered
- All management types were covered i.e. managed by Local Body/ Z.P / NP/ MNC, Private Aided, Private Unaided, Tribal Welfare Department. 5% of total schools were covered i.e. a total of 176 schools
- All school are selected according to management type and category of school.

Thus, final list of 176 schools was prepared. A special plan was made by the team and each of them has distributed the blocks and schools. The basic indicators for the survey were decided to be:

After selecting the schools, once again a detail discussion with the Investigators was made about the regular EMIS and the Actual Format of Survey. The queries and important suggestion were given to them. Most of the contact number of block level official given to them. A cell number of Programmer was given to them. We also held a practice session for filling the forms. The concept regarding the School Management, School type, School Category, Working areas, Building status was cleared to them. We stressed that each team members must be clear about the various aspects of the survey. Ultimately 10 people worked on the project. The list is enclosed with the reports. They were continuously in touch with the programmer.

Actual survey began on 1st March 2010. It took 15 days to finish data collection. They worked continuously for the survey within time period. They submitted the data on 15th March 2010. The forms submission and other details were taken from them on 31st March 2010.

Description of Tool

‘School Information Schedule’: A DISE DCF form was developed by NUEPA for all the states of India. It consists of eight parts seeking to collect information regarding the following heads:

1. **School Particulars :** This includes information about the school in terms of, the type of school, year of establishment, category of the schools, educational qualifications of the principals, type of residential schools, total number of teachers, previous academic year details, staff category, status and type of school building, number of block and classrooms with their conditions, infrastructural facilities available.
2. **Enrolment:** This includes information about students in terms of the total number of boys and girls caste category-wise in each class, students in terms of total number of boys and girls in each class on the basis of standard, attendance and attendance of disabled children.
3. **Repeaters and Re-Admission:** This includes information about the students in terms of total number of boys and girls in each class in the category of failures, long absentees and re-admissions.
4. **Extra facilities:** This includes information about the midday meal provided to students from different age, and category.
5. **Examination Results:** This includes information about the results of the previous academic session.
6. **Feedback of Investigators:** This part of the tool consists of feedback of the investigators regarding response of the school with their attribute, number of visits have been made for the data collection and kind of problems faced by the investigators during data collection in the school.

Data Collection

The principal investigator for the project visited the SSA offices of the four districts selected. The field investigators were selected from the same locality and given appropriate training for the data collection using DISE DCF from the selected schools. The training included mock sessions wherein every field investigators could have an experience of being source and the investigator. They were given time to understand the whole procedure and clarify their doubts. After this exercise in each district the field investigators visited the schools and collected the data.

The data collected was authenticated by certify of school principal and the respective BRC and CRC coordinators in the form of their signature and seal on the filled in DISE DCF. The data collection process was closely supervised, monitored and co-coordinated by the Teacher Trainers of the SSA office of each Block. The regular follow-up was maintained by the project team. The data collection was initiated on 4th Feb, 2010 and accomplished on 31th March, 2010. The data for the selected schools as collected by GCPE was also obtained from the appropriate sources.

Data Analysis

Data analysis was done using categorization, coding, tabulation and statistical analysis. Content analysis technique was also used for the analysis of the subjective responses. The sets of data collected by CASE field investigators team were processed in the same manner for the comparison to be made to look for the consistency of the data obtained.

ANALYSIS AND INTERPRETATION OF DATA OF THE DISTRICT

DISE Data Verification - Comparative Analysis

The major objective of the present exercise is to compare the data. An attempt has been made to compare the data in such a manner so that clear cut picture can emerge on various issues involved. The report also contains the observations of the field investigators on some important aspects relating to the day to day functioning of the schools.

A comparative analysis of data relating to ALL STUDENT Enrollment analyzed and presented in table 4&5 and match only in 99.70 per cent schools. An attempt has been made in table 4& 5 to present macro level variation in the primary school enrolment figures collected under DISE and sample checking survey. It contains data on an overall basis and also under the categories of SC, ST, and repeated children. There are minor variations in all the categories. However, the highest variation is seen in the categories of repeated children (99.7 per cent and 97.72 per cent) whereas the lowest variation is in the category of children belonging to Scheduled Castes.

Table deals with the data relating to the various incentives being provided to the different categories of students. It includes Enrolment , Appeared and Passed Students in LAST ANNUAL EXAMINATION RESULT. The overall variation is very low (97.91)

A comparative analysis of data makes it abundantly clear that the overall scenario with regard to the DISE data is mixed one. There are certain issues on which the variation was observed more whereas on certain issues there is no or very less variation. It can be said that lack of understanding and uniformity of definitions and lack of qualified and properly trained teachers may be some of the probable reasons of discrepancies in DISE data. On the basis of the analysis and interpretation done in the previous pages the major findings are being presented hereunder.

Summary of Field Observation

1) Training of Head Master:

The training of Head Master in filling up of DISE format, Field investigators came to know that all the Head Master received the training of DISE at Cluster level organized by Cluster Coordinator.

2) Infrastructure in the district MIS unit:

We found well furnished Computer Lab with broadband internet facility having 5 set of computers, 2 laser printers, One ½ KV Online. In MIS unit of SSA have One Computer Programmer and two data entry operators. But by taking in consideration the overload of work there is a need of extra two data entry operators in District MIS unit.

3) Key Information Display Board:

We observed that the key information is written regularly in all school. Good saying, news headlines, day, date is written attractively on the display board for pupils information. In average private school are aggressive in it.

4) Availability of DISE Data:

We found soft copy of DISE data available at district office since year 2003-04 to 2009-10 more than 70% people are well aware about EMIS /DISE data. We came to know that AWP and B 2008-09 that 100% DISE data is used for planning.

5) Data Feeding:

The training about data feeding is given to all programmers at state level. Training to Data Entry Operator Two days training given to Data Entry Operator at Maharashtra Institute of Educational Planning and Administration (MIEPA) Auragabad regarding ,

- How to installed Oracle and Dise Software
- EMIS data entry in the DISE Software
- Data Export /Import

Accurate Data feeding is also major activity in DISE data Collection, So Data Entry is done at Block level through Block Level Data Entry Operator.

We found that well learned computer professionals are available for the district MIS unit. According to us the existing DISE data is effective and well and good so there is no need of any change in it.

❖ Special D.C.F. for Post Enumeration Survey:

In 5% sample checking. All the parameters are checked. In Rural and Urban Area both the information from School obtained in DCF and the data obtained by Agency is same.

❖ Teacher in Position:

In this respect, in block wise survey we found that -

- ❖ In Pvt. Aided and unaided schools there are small changes in teacher's data.
- ❖ Here we can find small difference in the data.
- ❖ The teachers found more in the sample checking done by agency.

❖ School Facilities:

When we compared the data of agency with the school data we found few variations in Shirol and Shahuwadi Block. In block Shahuwadi DCF from school showing 34 classrooms but the Agency showing 34 classroom .No changes found in other blocks in district.

In the Status of schools building the information regarding Zilla Parishad and Municipal Council and Tribal Welfare Schools the data is accurate both in DCF and Data from Agency. But there is difference in Gov.and Rent.

❖ Class rooms:

The classrooms data found variation in Shahuwadi and Shirol Block. Some constructions of class rooms might be completed. It means these figures are not based on 30 September 2009. The figures are based on the day of survey. Class rooms are increasing. Physical facilities are developing at the school level in all type of management.

(Please refer Table No. 3B)

❖ **All Student enrollment data:**

The difference found in present enrolment as per the Data checked by the agency. Enrolment is increased by the 77 where boys are 45 and girls are 32. In 5 block the enrolment is slightly different. Instructions are given to the block level to check the enrolment of those schools which are surveyed by the investigators and send the class wise enrolment of all that schools.

(Refer Dist. Table No.4 & 5)

❖ **Attributes Pertaining to the Principal (P)/Head Teacher & Investigator :**

When surveyors went to 5% sample checking in district. They found 95% good response about initial reaction, 95 % Head masters had given the response in providing the information. All Head masters kept Availability of all type of records. Interaction of HM with surveyors found very good. Around 53 HM had good interaction with surveyors. Around 33 out 176 schools, HM has given very good response for giving the information to surveyors. Only 20 % schools of HM has given average response to the surveyors.

❖ **Pupils attendance on the day of survey:**

In overall 98 % students were present on the day of visit.

Our Experience / Suggestions

The major findings of the study conducted are presented in two subparts; one findings based on comparison of data and second findings based on Observation

A) Findings based on comparison of data

On comparing the data obtained from Sanstha and CASE for the 12 Blocks following were the findings:

The level of consistency was observed to be good with respect to the following variables in all the block distribution of schools by the year of establishment. While the variables which showed consistency in most of the blocks was: distribution of schools by qualification of principals/head teacher and the number of teachers in primary section.

Inconsistency was observed in 2 Blocks with respect to the distribution of schools by category, enrolment details of students, in examination results.

In rural and urban areas the information from schools obtained in the DCF and the PES data were same. But in school category there was little difference due to the change of higher classes. In the parameter "type of school" and "management" no difference was found.

There should be a committee of pupils to pay attention towards the cleanliness of premises of the school as well as the surroundings. This would give a feeling that it is their school

Teacher in Position : In this respect, in block wise survey was not found difference in the data.

B) Suggestions

- The list of VEC and SEC members should be displayed on a display board of the school.
- It is necessary to give training to the members of VEC and SEC to change their attitude to take care of school property.
- A committee of pupils should be constituted to pay attention towards the cleanliness of premises of the school as well as surroundings.
- The teachers should be given training about record maintenance so that Records are maintained properly.
- There should be playgrounds in all schools.
- Teachers and head teachers should pay more attention to disabled students.
- For the improvement of quality, there should be competitions like debate, essay writing, handwriting competitions which enables developing the personality of students.

C) Investigators Observations/Conclusion

Training of Headmaster:

All headmasters had received the training of the DISE at Cluster level organized by the cluster coordinator. Infrastructure in the district MIS unit: Taking in to consideration the overload of work there is a need of two extra data entry operators in District MIS unit. and schools the investigators got the evidence of DISE data sharing workshops at all levels.

Data Feeding:

The training of DISE Software is given to all programmers at state level. As per MPSP Guidelines data feeding of the DISE is done by the operators who are working in the BRC level. They are trained by the programmer and also by a two-day DISE Training at MIEPA, Aurangabad.

General Comments

- This checking proved useful for teachers in terms of maintenance of updated record.
- There is a lack of enough staff for maintaining records in some primary schools.

Availability of DISE Data:

The DISE data is available in hard and soft copies at district level. It is available on hard copies at Block level. At school level it is available in the form of school report card. About 70 to 75 percent people are well aware about DISE data and that the DISE data is used for annual planning.

Major Findings

1. There are **very less** variation in all the categories relating to the availability of school building, classrooms.
2. The data in the **two sets** almost match regarding the school particulars
3. Variations have been observed in the case of number of teaching days, educational supervision, CRC and BRC visits
4. There is **very less** variation in the two sets of data regarding primary level enrolment
5. The variation is found in the case of repeated children
6. Comparative analysis of data regarding annual exam conducted during last academic year (2008-09) under enrolled, appeared, and passed categories shows variation
7. Initial reaction of the heads of the institutions was positive in all schools
8. All the schools visited in district were found open on the day of the first visit
9. The seating arrangement for children in the school was found unsatisfactory. In majority of schools children sit on the mat in all the Blocks except in Shivnakwadi tal. Shirol, where furniture is available for children.

Recommendations -

1. It has been observed during the field work that teachers consider the DISE information as a routine one and hence do not pay desired attention while filling the DISE DCFs. In such a situation the quality of DISE data is always at stake. It is, therefore, suggested that Head Master / Teacher concerned should be made personally responsible for providing correct and accurate data.
2. During the field work several BRCs/CRCs point out that SSA personnel/officials are not treated at par with the officials of line department by the teachers. Therefore, there is a need to make some arrangement at the grassroots level to empower SSA officials as well. Training should be outsourced to some agency as teachers don't take seriously the training imparted by the CRCs. Training relating to DISE should also be imparted in the regular trainings as well. Coding pattern need to be made simpler as teachers get confused if the codes are written one after one (in continuation).
3. Black board should be written as chalk board in DISE DCFs as many teachers get confused on this count.
4. Private schools don't provide information in most of the cases as they do not have the information / data as required in DISE format..
5. It is suggested that in order to ensure the correct and consistent data from the schools the involvement of community / PTA must be ensured in the entire process. It should be made compulsory to obtain the signatures of PTA President and Vice President on the duly filled up DISE DCF so that they can also check the correctness of data relating to their school.
